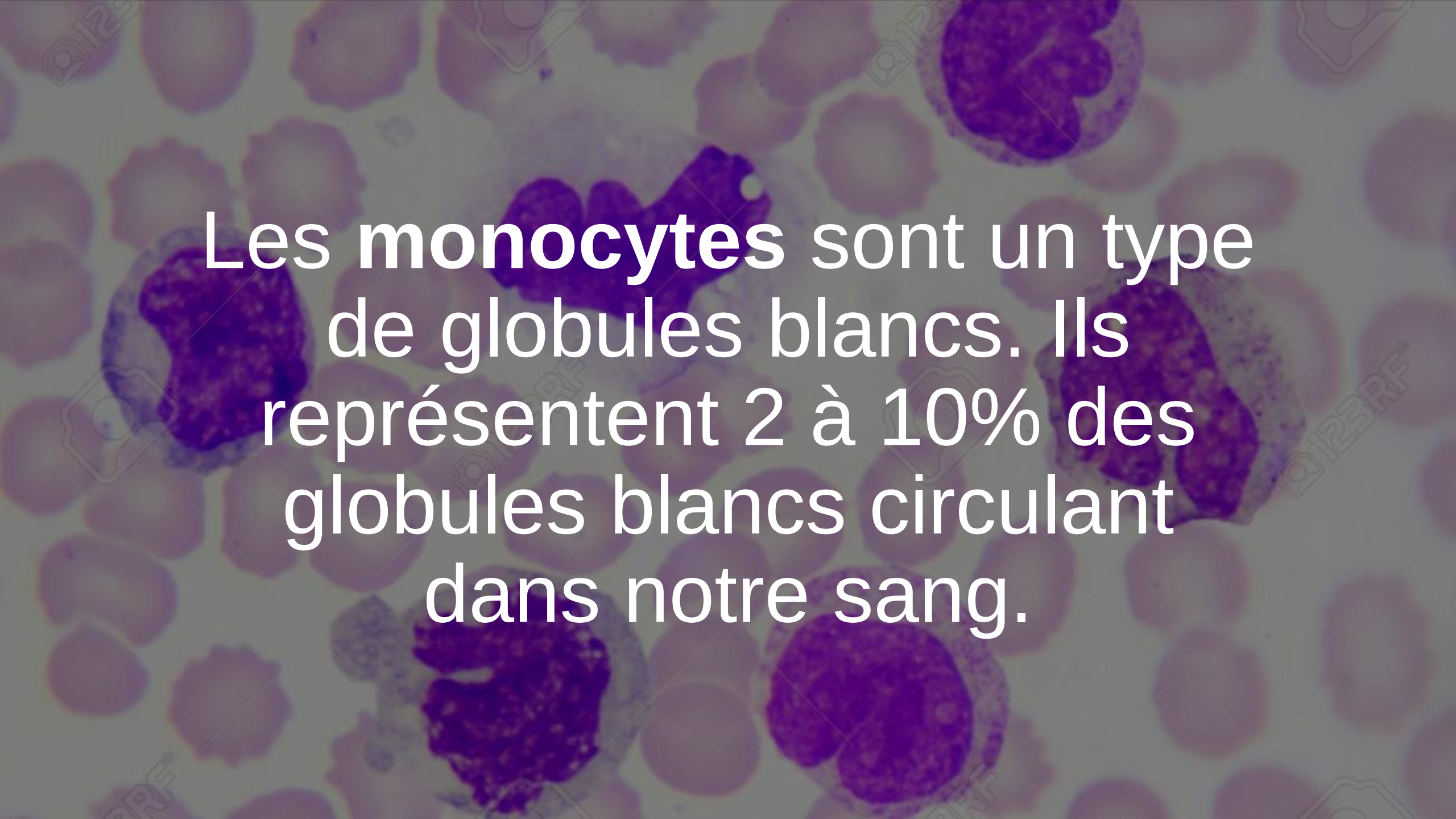

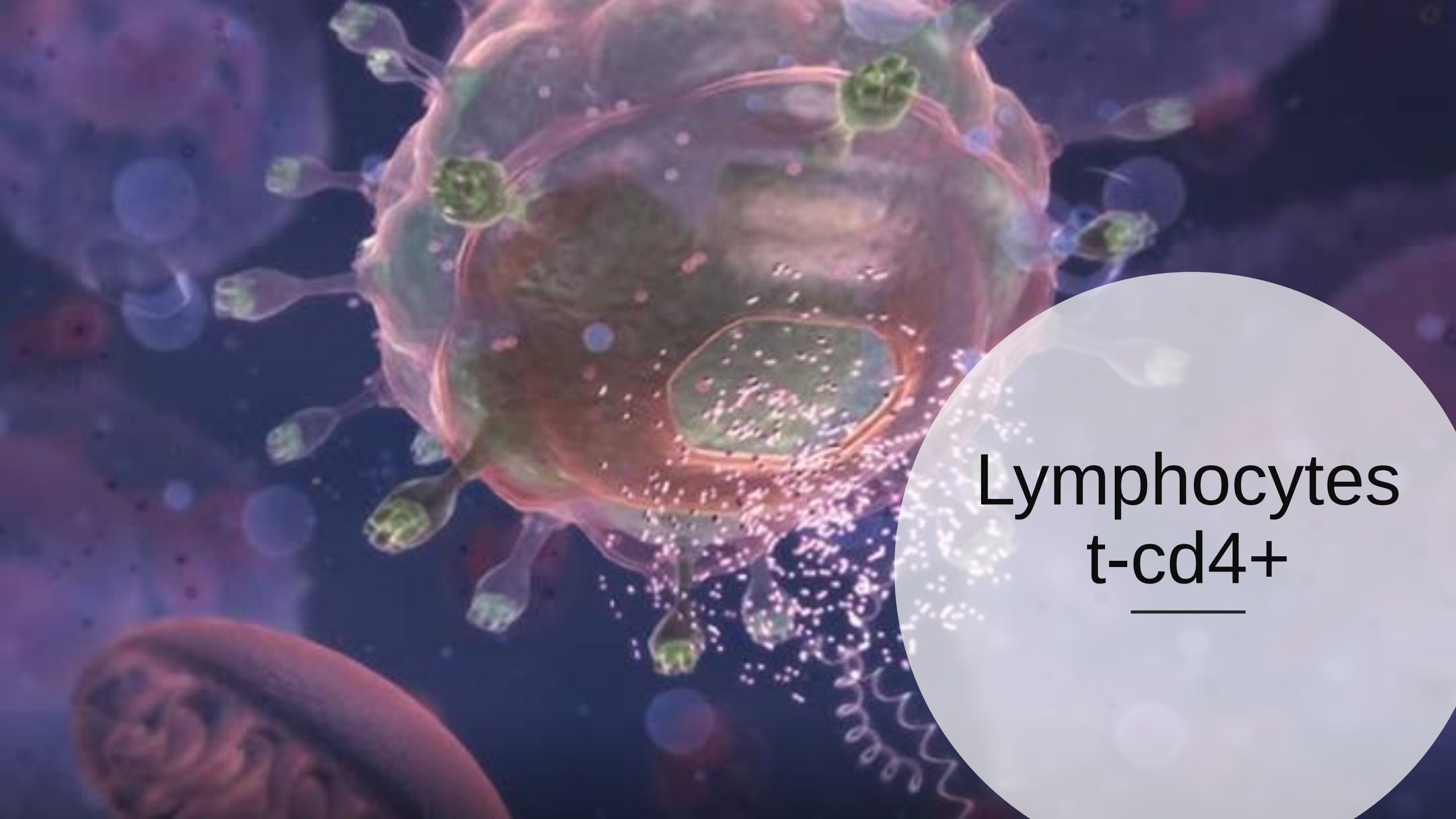

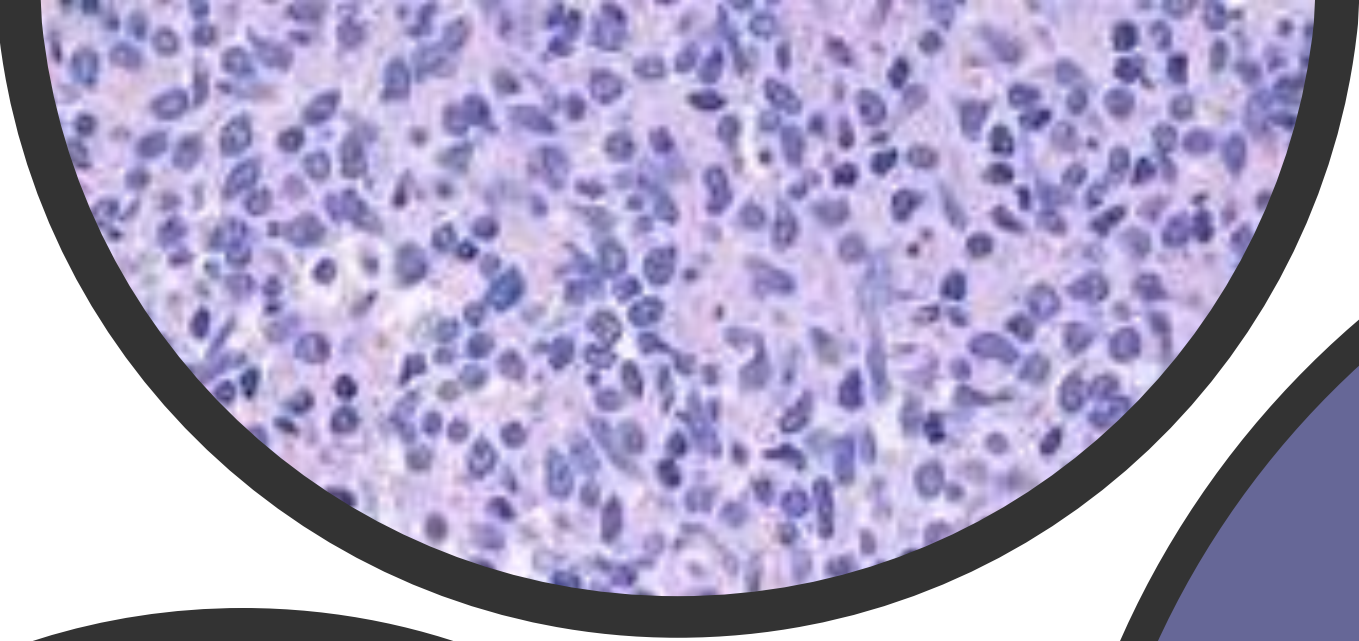
C'est une cellule souche engagée dans une lignée cellulaire, capable de provoquer une évolution dans la descendance.
